

## RATIFICATION OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS

Until the Board of Education has voted to ratify a collective bargaining agreement with an employee bargaining unit, no part of such new agreement shall be deemed enforceable, or to have any force or effect, unless otherwise required by law. Prior to the Board of Education placing ratification of a collective bargaining agreement on its agenda, the particular employee bargaining unit shall first have held a meeting of its general membership at which time the agreement was ratified.
