

ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS

The Board of Education delegates to the Superintendent of Schools the responsibility of developing and approving administrative regulations, as needed, to implement Board policies. Administrative regulations do not need the approval of the Board except when required by law. In such case, the Board shall adopt administrative regulations in accordance with the procedure for policies as outlined in policy 2400.

An administrative regulation must be consistent in every respect with the policy adopted by the Board to which it is related. Copies of all administrative regulations shall be distributed to the Board at the time they are approved by the Superintendent.

If any provision of an administrative regulation is determined to be illegal or unconstitutional, the validity and effectiveness of all the remaining provisions of that regulation shall not be affected thereby, and the latter shall remain in full force and effect.

Administrative regulations shall be included in the district policy manual and disseminated in the same manner as Board of Education policies.
