

SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

The Board of Education shall by a majority vote appoint a Superintendent of Schools. The Superintendent shall serve as the chief executive officer of the Board and as such shall carry out the policies established by the Board.

The Board of Education may enter into a contract with the Superintendent of Schools, as permitted by law, for a duration of not less than three years and not exceeding five years, and may renew such contract periodically.
