

PUBLIC SALES ON SCHOOL DISTRICT PROPERTY

The Board of Education recognizes that the general prohibition against commercial activity on school district property does allow activities which are in furtherance of an educational or charitable purpose.

Accordingly, the Board hereby authorizes the use of school district buildings and property for public sales and other functions when the proceeds are to benefit educational or charitable purposes.

The Superintendent of Schools is authorized to promulgate such regulations and directives as are necessary to implement the provisions of this policy.
