

PUBLIC INFORMATION FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT VOTES

The Board of Education shall take reasonable steps to inform the community about school board elections and votes on the budget and other proposition(s), if any.

A public information meeting shall be scheduled prior to Board-adoption of the budget in order to include input from the public in the final budget to be presented to the voters. A Public Hearing will be conducted and a tax information notification will be distributed, both in accordance with NYS Education Law.

The Board may allocate funds for the preparation and distribution of brochures, flyers, letters and other similar communications.

The Superintendent of Schools shall approve all information prepared regarding district expenditure submitted to the voters for approval. The Superintendent shall ensure that any document, newsletter, advertisement or other communication prepared and/or distributed at district expense shall be factual in nature and shall not exhort voters to approve or disapprove any matter submitted to voters.
