

SPECIAL DISTRICT MEETINGS

In accordance with state law, the Board of Education may hold special district meetings for the purpose of a vote of the registered voters of the community on the following issues:

1. a revote on the school district budget which has been previously rejected by the voters of the community;
2. a revised budget;
3. the election of Trustees of the Board of the Finkelstein Memorial Library;
4. a vote or revote on the budget of the Finkelstein Memorial Library;
5. capital projects;
6. purchase of property;
7. sale of district-owned property; and/or
8. any other issue for which the Board requires community approval.

A special district meeting may be held on any day of the week other than Sundays and holidays. A revote on the school district or library budget may be held no sooner than 14 days after the previous vote.

Notice of Special District Meeting

Except for a special district meeting held for a revote on the budget, notice of a special district meeting shall be given in a manner similar to the notice for the annual meeting and election.

Notice of a special district meeting for a revote on the budget shall be given once each week for two consecutive weeks immediately preceding the vote. The notice shall be published in two newspapers, if there are two, and in one newspaper if there is only one with general circulation in the school district.

Library Meetings

In accordance with state law, the Board of Finkelstein Memorial Library, in its discretion, may call a special meeting for the purpose of electing library trustees, voting on a library budget, or for any proper library purpose. Such a meeting shall be held subsequent to April 1, but prior to July 1, of each year.

The Board of Registration shall meet and notice of the meeting shall be given as provided by law. The cost of all such meetings and registrations shall be borne by the library.

Should the Board of Trustees of the Library decide not to conduct a special meeting for the reasons noted above, then the library vote shall be held and notice of it shall be given by the Board of Education as part of its annual meeting and election.
