

SCHOOL ADMISSIONS AND COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE AGES

The East Ramapo Central School District shall provide a free public education as permitted or required by state statutes.

All children between six years of age and through the end of the school year in which the student turns sixteen years of age are required by New York State law to attend school for full time instruction in a public, private or parochial school, unless exempt from attendance in conjunction with current law and approved by the State Education Department.

The Superintendent of Schools shall assure that appropriate regulations and procedures are developed to implement this policy.
